The 2021 Challenge runs from 4am Saturday, May 29th until midnight Sept. 6, Labor Day 2021!

Catch 15 Species On the Fly!

Fee to participate in the Challenge is \$25 for Individuals and \$100 for Teams.

The Winner of the Individual Challenge gets 1/2 the Individual pot, a traveling trophy and bragging rights. TU420 Chapter retains the other 1/2 of the pot.

The winning Team will win a Guided Fishing Trip, hosted by Donavan Clary, on one of our great Oklahoma waters. His choice and subject to availability.

Awards and prizes will presented at the September 9th TU420 meeting.

- 11. Green Sunfish

#### **RULES:**

# **Individual Challenge Event:**

- Individual Entry Fee is \$25
- All species must be caught with a fly rod and fly in Oklahoma.
- All participants must join the All Fish All Oklahoma Fly Fishing Challenge Facebook Group page.
- You must take a photo of the fish with something having your name on it, or as a selfie.
- Pictures must be posted with date of catch, place of catch and species claimed.
- Pictures must be posted to the Facebook Group within one week of the catch.
- The species claimed will be confirmed by the judges prior to updating the Tournament Board.

- All judges rulings are final.
- It is not a race, so, pace yourself.
- Catch and post pictures of all 15 species to be eligible to win the challenge.
- All catches are to be made in a legal manor obeying all Oklahoma fishing regulations.
- Snagged fish do not count.
- If an Individual is, also, participating in the Team Challenge Event, the Fish posting CANNOT be shared. i.e. Catching a Bluegill as a Team catch DOES NOT qualify as an Individual catch, also.
- If more than one person completes the challenge, the winner will be determined by random drawing at the September TU420 meeting.

### **Big Fish Competition: (Excluded from the Team Challenge)**

- You must have purchased an Individual Entry to compete in this portion of the Challenge.
- This portion of the Challenge does not apply to Teams.
- Separate, non-monetary prizes will be awarded for largest fish of these species:
  - o Rainbow
  - Smallmouth
  - Largemouth
  - Striped Bass
  - Sand Bass
  - o Bluegill.
- For largest fish entries, carry a tape measure or bump board and include it in the picture, with your name, date and place of catch to qualify.
- Do the best you can when measuring and you may round up to the nearest quarter inch.
- The measurement must be legible for the Judges to see.
- You can log multiple entries. Enter your largest catch anytime you catch a larger fish than your first entry or anytime you catch a fish larger than the current holder of the slot.
- There are no Ties for these categories. Example: 2 people catch a 21 inch Largemouth. The first person to log their catch on the Facebook Group page will be awarded the slot. A 21.25 Largemouth must be logged to knock them out of the spot.

# **Team Challenge Event:**

- Team Entry Fee is \$100.
- Team consists of 4 members.
- Teams will follow the same rules as the Individual Challenge Event with one additional rule:
  - Each team member must catch 3 separate species. If this is confusing, ask a judge to explain.
- If a Team member is, also, participating in the Individual Challenge Event, the Fish posting CANNOT be shared. i.e. Catching a Bluegill as a Team catch DOES NOT qualify as an Individual catch, also.
- If more than 1 team completes the challenge, the winner will be selected from the teams completing the challenge by random drawing at the September TU420 meeting.
