# The 2024 All Fish All Oklahoma Fly Fishing Challenge

**Type of Tournament:** Fly Fishing ONLY – Individual or 4 Man Team **Tournament Entry Fee:** Individual Entry - \$30. Team Entry - \$100

**Tournament Begins:** Saturday, May 25<sup>th</sup>, 2024, at 5am (Memorial Day Weekend) **Tournament Ends:** Monday, September 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2024 at Midnight (Labor Day)

Awards: Awards program to be held on the Second Thursday in September

Individual Winner receives half of the Total Individual Entry Fees Team Winner receives a Guided Trip by Donavan Clary (see details)

Specific Prizes for Big Fish Category (see qualification rules)

### **Rules:**

This is a Fly Fishing Challenge. All fish must be caught using a Fly Rod and Fly and released back to the water. This is also a multi-species tournament, and you will have 15 weeks to catch 15 different Species of fish, in the state of Oklahoma. This tournament is also referred to as the  $15 \times 15$ .

## The Species are:

- 1. Rainbow Trout
- 2. Smallmouth Bass
- 3. Largemouth Bass
- 4. Kentucky Bass aka Spotted Bass
- 5. Striped Bass
- 6. Sand Bass aka White Bass
- 7. Hybrid Striper/Sand Bass
- 8. Crappie
- 9. Bluegill
- 10. Longear Sunfish
- 11. Green Sunfish
- 12. Redear Sunfish
- 13. Channel Catfish
- 14. Drum
- 15. Wild Card Fish is any fish species not on the list above (all other rules apply)

# **Species Submission Qualifications:**

- 1. You must submit the photo to the FB Tournament page
  - a. Search FB for All Fish All Oklahoma Fly Fishing Challenge private page and request membership, if you don't already have access.
- 2. The Photo must be a Selfie with you and the Fish Or a Photo of the Fish and the 2024 Challenge Badge with Your Name on the Badge.
- 3. The FB Post must contain the following:
  - a. Photo

- b. Species
- c. Date Caught
- d. Body of Water that the fish was caught in.
  - i. Examples: LIR, Arkansas River, Owasso Neighborhood Pond, etc..
- 4. FB Post must be made within 1 week of the catch
- 5. No submissions will be accepted after the Close of the Tournament.

## **Individual Challenge**

To complete the Individual Challenge and get your name entered into the Individual Winners Drawing, you must pay the \$30 Individual Entry Fee and Catch and Release all 15 species in the Tournament duration time and submit the species via the Tournament App. Species may be caught in Public or Private waters.

### **Team Challenge**

To complete the Team Challenge and get your team entered into the Team Winners Drawing, your team must pay the \$100 Team Entry Fee and Catch and Release all 15 species in the Tournament duration time and submit the species via the Tournament App. Additionally, each Team Member must catch 3 unique species. Example: 3 members catch the same 3 species and 1 member catches the rest, does not qualify. Species may be caught in Public or Private waters.

**Team Challenge Prize:** One day float trip for the winning 4-person team. Upper Illinois River or Lower Illinois River. Must be taken Saturday or Sunday Sept. 28 or 29. Prize offered by Donavan Clary Fishing. \$1,200 value.

# **Strategies:**

You may enter the Individual Challenge as many times as you like. However, you cannot resubmit catches from previous entries.

You may be a member on as many Teams as you like. However, you cannot resubmit catches from previous entries.

You may be a Team Challenge participant and an Individual Challenge participant, also. However, you cannot resubmit catches from previous entries.

## **Big Fish Challenge**

This is the Challenge within the Challenge.

NOTE: You can only participate in this portion of the Challenge if you have paid an Individual Entry Fee. You must follow the same rules for Species Submission Qualifications along with these other qualifications:

- 1. The 2024 Challenge Badge with Your Name on it, must be visible in the picture.
- 2. You must use a Bump Board with the measurements clearly visible.
- 3. Species must be caught in public waters.

# **Big Fish Species and Specific Prizes:**

- **1. Rainbow Trout:** ½ day Guided trip for 2 on the LMF with Beavers Bend Fly Fishing. (Must be an agreed upon time schedule and booked in advance.) Value \$295
- 2. Smallmouth: Selection of Smallmouth flies from Donavan Clary Fishing \$250 value
- **3. Bluegill:** 1-year day pass to Sparrowhawk Resort on the Upper Illinois River. (Some restrictions will apply.) Winner will receive a vehicle sticker with a gate code. Sticker must be displayed, good for 9/1/2024 to 8/31/2025 a \$500 value.
- 4. Largemouth Bass: Custom made fishing knife by Brian Edwards Custom Knives. value \$350
- **5. Striper:** Guided trip for 2 on Lake Texoma from Chris Gorman of KEKOA Outdoors. (Based on availability and scheduling in advance required.)
- **6. Biggest Catfish:** (Any species, channel, blue or flathead) From River Banks Outdoor Adventures winner gets a guided trip on Lake Texhoma to catch a world record... rod and reel, flyfishing or noodling. (Trip based on availability scheduling in advance is required.) \$400 value
- 7. Biggest Redear: Sun hoodie, hat and stickers from Okie on the Fly \$60 value
- **8. Biggest Sandbass:** Gift assortment of hat, shirt and assorted sandbass flies from Big Daddy's Bait and Tackle store. \$75 value
