The 2025 All Fish All Oklahoma Fly Fishing Challenge

Type of Tournament: Fly Fishing ONLY – Individual or 4 Man Team **Tournament Entry Fee:** Individual Entry - \$30. Team Entry - \$100

Tournament Begins: Saturday, May 24th, 2025, at 5am (Memorial Day Weekend) **Tournament Ends:** Monday, September 1st, 2025 at Midnight (Labor Day)

Awards:

Awards program to be held on the Second Thursday in September. This year, awards will be distributed as follows:

Individual Challenge Winners

1st Place awarded One Third of the Total Individual Entry Fees

2nd Place awarded a Lamson Guru 2 Fly Reel

3rd Place awarded a Loon Fly Tying Tools Kit

Team Challenge Winner

Receives a One-day float trip for the winning 4-person team. The trip must be taken Saturday Oct. 4⁻ 2025 or Saturday Oct 11, 2025. Prize offered by Donavan Clary Fishing and will be on the Upper Illinois River or Lower Illinois River based on river conditions.

Rules:

This is a Fly Fishing Challenge. All fish must be caught using a Fly Rod and Fly and released back into the water. This is also a multi-species tournament, and you will have 15 weeks to catch 15 different Species of fish, in the state of Oklahoma. This tournament is also referred to as the 15×15 .

The Species are:

- 1. Rainbow Trout
- 2. Smallmouth Bass
- 3. Largemouth Bass
- 4. Kentucky Bass aka Spotted Bass
- 5. Striped Bass
- 6. Sand Bass aka White Bass
- 7. Hybrid Striper/Sand Bass
- 8. Crappie
- 9. Bluegill
- 10. Longear Sunfish
- 11. Green Sunfish
- 12. Redear Sunfish
- 13. Channel Catfish
- 14. Drum
- 15. Wild Card Fish is any fish species not on the list above (all other rules apply)

Species Submission Qualifications:

- 1. You must submit the photo to the FB Tournament page
 - a. Search FB for All Fish All Oklahoma Fly Fishing Challenge private page and request membership, if you don't already have access.
- 2. The Photo must be a Selfie with you and the Fish Or a Photo of the Fish and the 2025 Challenge Badge with Your Name on the Badge.
- 3. The FB Post must contain the following:
 - a. Photo
 - b. Species
 - c. Date Caught
 - d. Body of Water that the fish was caught in.
 - i. Examples: LIR, Arkansas River, Owasso Neighborhood Pond, etc..
- 4. FB Post must be made within 1 week of the catch
- 5. No submissions will be accepted after the Close of the Tournament.

Individual Challenge

To complete the Individual Challenge and get your name entered into the Individual Winners Drawing, you must pay the \$30 Individual Entry Fee and Catch and Release all 15 species in the Tournament duration time and submit the species via the Tournament App. Species may be caught in Public or Private waters.

Team Challenge

To complete the Team Challenge and get your team entered into the Team Winners Drawing, your team must pay the \$100 Team Entry Fee and Catch and Release all 15 species in the Tournament duration time and submit the species via the Tournament App. Additionally, each Team Member must catch 3 unique species. Example: 3 members catch the same 3 species and 1 member catches the rest, does not qualify. Species may be caught in Public or Private waters.

Strategies:

You may enter the Individual Challenge as many times as you like. However, you cannot resubmit catches from previous entries.

You may be a member on as many Teams as you like. However, you cannot resubmit catches from previous entries.

You may be a Team Challenge participant and an Individual Challenge participant, also. However, you cannot resubmit catches from previous entries.

Big Fish Challenge

This is the Challenge within the Challenge.

NOTE: You can only participate in this portion of the Challenge if you have paid an Individual Entry Fee. You must follow the same rules for Species Submission Qualifications along with these other qualifications:

- 1. The 2025 Challenge Badge with Your Name on it, must be visible in the picture.
- 2. Use a Bump Board or Tape measure with the measurements clearly visible.
- 3. Species must be caught in public waters.
